Purpose and scope

“Okeo Payments, UAB” (also referred to as **we, us, Okeo Payments, Company**) is an electronic money institution licensed by the Bank of Lithuania ([license no. 71](#)), incorporated and existing in Vilnius, Lithuania, company registration number 305219549, having its registered address at Gedimino pr. 20, LT-01103, Vilnius.

Okeo Payments is committed to protect the privacy of your personal data in accordance with the applicable laws, including the General Data Protection Regulation (2016/679) and other applicable legal acts. We value your privacy and we only collect and use your personal data in accordance with our [Privacy Policy](#), this Cookies Policy and binding provisions of the law.

This Cookies Policy explains what cookies are, what type of cookies we use when you visit our website at <https://okeo.com/> (hereinafter – the Website), what information we collect using the cookies and how that information is used.

What are cookies

Cookies are small text files generated by a website and saved by your browser when you visit various websites on the internet. We use cookies on our Website too.

With the help of cookies, we may understand how you are interacting with our Website, determine your preferences and improve your online experience.

What cookies do we use

Some cookies that we use are allocated to your device only for the duration of your visit on the Website, and these are called “*session based*” cookies. These cookies automatically expire at the end of the session – when the web browser is closed. Other cookies that we use, known as “*persistent cookies*”,

consist of text files sent by a web server to a web browser, and are subsequently stored by the web browser. They remain valid until their expiry date (unless deleted by the user before the expiry date).

There are cookies created and used directly by our Website, the so-called "*first-party cookies*". The information stored in them can be read only by our Website. The "*Third party cookies*" are cookies that are placed on our Website when we use the external services.

We have three types of cookies on our Website:

Type of cookies	Description
1. Preference cookies	Preference Cookies enable a website to remember information that changes the way our Website behaves or looks, like your preferred language or the region that you are in.
2. Statistics Cookies	Statistics Cookies are used to analyse how our Website is being accessed, used or is performing, in order to provide you with the best user experience and to maintain, operate and continuously improve our Website. Information related to the Statistics Cookies that we use is collected and reported anonymously.
3. Marketing Cookies	Marketing Cookies are used to provide you with more relevant advertising. They are often served by third parties and are specifically designed to gather information on your device to display advertisements on topics that are potentially more interesting for you.

More information about the cookies used on our Website is provided below:

1. lang (preference cookies)	Set by LinkedIn to remember the selected website language version.	Session
2. _ga	Registers a unique ID that is used to generate statistical data on how the visitor uses the website.	2 years
3. _ga_#	Used by Google Analytics to collect data on the number of times a user has visited the website as well as dates for the first and most recent visit.	2 years
4. personalization_id	Set by Twitter to allow the visitor to share content from the website onto user's Twitter profile.	2 years
5. _fbp	Used by Facebook to deliver a series of advertisement products such as real time bidding from third party advertisers.	3 months
6. bcookie	Used by the social networking service LinkedIn for tracking the use of embedded services.	2 years
7. bscookie	Used by the social networking service LinkedIn for tracking the use of embedded services.	2 years
8. lang (marketing cookies)	Set by LinkedIn when a web page contains an embedded "Follow us" panel.	Session

Cookie name	Purpose	Expiry
9. lidc	Used by the social networking service, LinkedIn, for tracking the use of embedded services.	1 day
10. tr	Used by Facebook to deliver a series of advertisement products such as real time bidding from third party advertisers.	Session
11. UserMatchHistory	Set by LinkedIn to track visitors on multiple websites, in order to present relevant advertisement based on the visitor's preferences.	30 days
12. li_gc	Used by the social networking service, LinkedIn, to store consent of guests regarding the use of cookies for non-essential purposes	30 days
13. AnalyticsSyncHistory	Used by social networking service, LinkedIn, to store information about the time a sync with the lms_analytics cookie took place for users in the Designated Countries	30 days

Our Website may display content from the external service providers, such as YouTube, Facebook, Twitter or LinkedIn, e.g. after using these providers' "Like" button or the link to these providers' websites.
